Robert Zverina: Flattened Can Spiral



Sound Transit "STart on Broadway" Temporary Art Installation September 7 – November 1, 2008

...Approximately 1,400 traffic-flattened aluminum cans assembled in a spiral shape.

Cans were picked off the streets of Seattle since early 2005 and new ones continue to be collected. This is the 6th and largest incarnation of the spiral re-using the same cans, but this is the first semi-permanent installation, with each can fastened to the asphalt using a ³/₄' galvanized roofing nail. Total assembly time was approximately 20 hours.

After the exhibit, the spiral will be disassembled once more and the cans will be put into storage awaiting their next opportunity to see the light of day. It is hoped one day to install the spiral permanently. Inquiries should be directed to rob@zverina.com.
